

**City of Twin Oaks  
Park Committee Meeting Minutes  
March 10, 2022**

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

**Roll Call**

**Approval of Agenda**

Doug moved to approve the agenda as written, seconded by Janet - Approved 4-0

**Approval of February 10, 2022 Minutes**

**Staff Report**

John reported some of the concrete at the playground pavillion is cracking. He has received a bid of \$5,000 to repair it.

Two new basketball backboards need replaced. The cost is approximately \$1,800 for both plus \$700 for installation.

The cost to replace the toilets in the men's restroom is approximately \$2,500 - \$3,000. John is also researching replacement of the heater in the men's restroom which will cost approximately \$5,000 plus installation.

**Events**

Chili Cookoff/Bingo Night – Final plans for the event were discussed. Eleven people entered the cookoff and approximately 70 people signed up for bingo.

Easter Egg Hunt (4/16) – The person posing as the Easter bunny had been confirmed, candy to fill the eggs and additional plastic eggs were purchased. Some Easter signs to be placed in the park the day of the event were also purchased. The PC members were asked to be in the park at 8:00 a.m. the day of the event to hide the eggs for the 10:00 a.m. hunt. The park will be sectioned off in three areas – for children ages 1 – 4, ages 5 – 7 and 8 and up. There will be a prize for the child finding the golden egg in each age group. Cookies and water will be served. The committee members plan to stuff the eggs on Saturday, April 9, at 9:00 a.m. at City Hall.

June 4 Concert in the Park- The bank Jukebox Heroes was confirmed. The City will be sending them a contract to sign.

July 2 Concert – Laytham & Holmes were confirmed and need a contract to sign.

August 4 Concert – Janet is looking for a band for this concert.

### **Story Boards**

Doug presented to the committee the information he had obtained regarding approximate cost and installation of story boards in the park. There was discussion on whether we could install the boards ourselves versus having the work done by an outside company. Doug agreed to present the story board concept and costs involved to the Board at one of their April meetings for their consideration.
