June Concert Band – Joe was contacted by Sherry McGuire with the band, Cheribomb. The band would like to perform at one of the concerts in the park. Sherry is a resident of Twin Oaks. Joe is going to talk with her and confirm the bands availability for the June concert date and determine the cost for them to perform. He is going to then communicate with the PC members what he learned and if the committee agrees ask Paula to send Sherry a contract.

Movie Night Rental – It was determined at the October PC meeting to have a movie night in the park on October 10 in conjunction with National Night Out. It was suggested we have a second movie night possibly in June. Before purchasing a screen and other equipment, it was decided to find out where the screen and equipment could be rented and how much it would cost.

Park Projects and Improvements – The committee members were asked to again consider ideas for use of the cow pond area in addition to further consideration of installing disc golf in the area.
