AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A PERSONAL SPENDING ACCOUNT (PSA) FOR THE VILLAGE OF TWIN OAKS FOR ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES:

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees wishes to provide a Personal Spending Account benefit to its eligible employees \$2,500 annually; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees wishes to divide the annual amount by 27 pay periods for 2014 and 26 pay periods beginning 2015;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Twin Oaks, St. Louis County, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. The Village Clerk/Controller is hereby authorized and directed to set up with the payroll provider, a special payroll earnings field that would include funds for a personal spending account.

Section 2. The commencement of the personal spending account will begin on the April 9, 2014 payroll beginning with a lump sum for the first seven (7) payroll periods and the remainder divided between the last 20 payroll periods of 2014.

Section 3. Eligible employees are those full-time and permanent part-time employees who work more than 25 hours per week throughout the year.
