AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EMPLOYMENT OF JOHN M. HESSEL OF LEWIS RICE LLC TO SERVE AS VILLAGE ATTORNEY ON AN INTERIM BASIS.

WHEREAS, as a result of the passing of Robert Hartzog the Village needs to hire a new Village Attorney, and

WHEREAS, the Board will engage in a search process to select an attorney to succeed Robert Hartzog and such a process will take several months to complete, and

WHEREAS, the Board has asked John M. Hessel of Lewis Rice LLC to serve as Village Attorney during this search process.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Twin Oaks, St. Louis County, Missouri, as follows:

SECTION 1. The law firm of LEWIS RICE LLC is employed by the Village with John M. Hessel acting as Village Attorney on an interim basis at the hourly rate of \$280. Billings shall be rendered monthly and shall be due and payable upon review by the Trustees at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage as provided by law.
