A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR PARK PLANNING GRANT WITH THE MUNICIPAL PARK GRANT COMMISSION

Whereas, the Municipal Park Grant Commission (the "Commission") makes planning grants available each fall that are designed to continue to improve facility grant applications; and,

Whereas, the City of Twin Oaks ("Twin Oaks") desires to apply for a planning grant from the Commission that will pay for 20% of the costs, not to exceed \$7,680.00, of specialized planning services for trails and park access.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF TWIN OAKS, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section One.</u> The Board hereby authorizes the Mayor or the City Administrator to make application to the Municipal Parks Grant Program for a grant-in-aid for costs related to the extension of walking trails to the "North Woods" section of Twin Oaks Park in conjunction with the creek restoration process currently underway to correct erosion problems and return the storm water creek to a more natural condition (the "Planning Grant") (application attached and incorporated herein by reference).

<u>Section Two.</u> If the Planning Grant is awarded and accepted, Twin Oaks will enter into an agreement with the Commission relating to the grant.

<u>Section Three</u>. This Resolution adopted hereby shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval.
