ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

- Twin Oaks Town Hall: Wright Construction is working on the punch list items. We did receive our occupancy permit and keys to the building this week. Our new furniture is scheduled to come in at the end of the week from ColorArt. We have planned the office move for February 15th.
- Villages at Big Bend Square: We are still waiting for Haley Holdings (Propper) to submit their master signage plan. We are in the process of reviewing the new signage for Kriegers and have given temporary zoning approval for the remaining signs until the master signage plan is received.
- Big Bend Lighting: Just a progress report; we have made contact with Commerce about additional lighting on their side of Big Bend and have also contacted Regions about the adjustment of their poles.
- Twin Oaks Presbyterian Church: The TOPC has made a request to the Board of Adjustment to install a custom shed behind the church. I

wanted to ask the Board if they would allow me to waive the fees associated with the request (except for the court reporter) since they have been so generous with us using their building for special meetings this past year.
