NEW BUSINESS

Consideration of Amendments to Section 400.550 of the City of Twin Oaks Municipal Code Pertaining to the membership of the Planning and Zoning Commission and Related Text.

City Clerk Johnson stated that the amendment would increase the number of citizen members of the commission from the current seven (7) to nine (9). In response to a question from Commissioner Brown, City Clerk Johnson explained why the change was being proposed. The City recently received four applications for the two available spots on the Commission. The Board of Alderman, rather than turn away residents interested in community service, decided to increase the number of commissioners to allow all applicants to be appointed to the commission. Chairman Venturella added that he believes working to have a geographically diverse membership on the Commission is important to its effective operation.

Commissioner Krewson moved, seconded by Commissioner Brown, to amend Section 400.550 as proposed. The motion passed on a voice vote.

Mayor Fortune moved, seconded by Commissioner Krewson, to table consideration of the amendment to the next meeting of the Planning and Zoning Commission. The motion passed on a voice vote.
