Notice is hereby given, that the City of Twin Oaks will receive sealed bids for construction of 2022 Curb Improvement Project. The scope will also include traffic control. All other incidental items of work will be shown and described in the Project Plans and Project Specifications.

Concrete curbs and asphalt curbs to be removed and replaced will be marked.

Sealed Bids will be received by the City of Twin Oaks until 11:00 A.M. on Tuesday, September 13, 2022, and will thereafter be publicly opened and read aloud.

The successful bidder shall be required to comply with the current State Statutory Provisions concerning the payment of Prevailing Wages on Public Works, Section 290.210 through 290.340 and 290.550 to 290.580 RSMo 2000, and shall pay to all workmen performing work under this contract not less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages determined by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations of the State of Missouri.

Depending on whether the project amount exceeds \$75,000, Missouri Annual Wage Order 29 may be in effect for this project.

Each bid must be accompanied by a cashier's check, or certified check, or a Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and an approved surety company and payable to the City of Twin Oaks, in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the sum total of the base bid plus all alternate bids.

A Performance Bond and Payment and Materials Bond will be required for this project.

The City intends to award a contract for the Project based on the bid that, in the City's sole discretion, is the best, lowest, and most responsive bid that best meets the interests and requirements of the City best meets the interests and requirements of the City. The City reserves the right in the City's sole discretion to reject any and all bids, to waive technicalities or deficiencies in any or all bids, to negotiate with any or all bidders or others for more favorable terms or prices, and to award a contract to other than the bidder submitting the lowest cost bid proposal, with or without negotiation. The City reserves the right not to open a sole bid. No Bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days subsequent to the specified time for receipt of Bids.

The City of Twin Oaks intends to issue the Notice to Proceed on or about Thursday, September 22, 2022.

The successful bidder shall require all on-site employees to complete a ten-hour Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) construction safety program provided by the contractor which includes a course in construction safety and health approved by OSHA or a similar program approved by MoDOLIR which is at least as stringent as an approved OSHA program, as required under Subsection 292.675.2 RSMo. All employees are required to complete the program within sixty days of beginning work under this contract. The successful bidder shall also require all subcontractors under the contractor to provide the ten-hour training program required under Subsection 292.675.2 RSMo. to such subcontractors' on-site employees.

The successful bidder shall comply with Section 285.530 RSMo., pertaining to enrollment and participation in a federal work authorization program (as defined therein) and shall provide verification through an affidavit (attached as Exhibit B) that the bidder (1) does not knowingly employ any person who is an unauthorized alien in connection with the Contract and (2) is enrolled in a federal work authorization program and provide documentary proof thereof. The affidavit shall contain the notarized signature of the registered agent, legal representative or corporate officer of the business entity including but not limited to the human resources director or their equivalent.

Section 208.009 RSMo., requires that all applicants <u>at the time of application</u> <u>for any contract</u> provided by a local government provide "affirmative proof that the applicant is a citizen or a permanent resident of the United States or is lawfully present in the United States." All bidders must provide affirmative proof established through (i) a Missouri driver's license, (ii) any "documentary evidence recognized by the department of revenue when processing an application for a driver's license," or (iii) "any document issued by the federal government that confirms an alien's lawful presence in the United States." §208.009.3 RSMo.
