MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF TWIN OAKS, TWIN OAKS TOWN HALL ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI WEDNESDAY, JUNE 16, 2021

The meeting of the Twin Oaks Board of Aldermen was called to order at 7:01 pm. Roll Call was taken:

Permanent records are kept of all minutes and ordinances. Each ordinance is read a minimum of two times by title, unless otherwise noted.

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

Mayor Fortune asked if there were any changes to the agenda. Hearing none, Alderman Milne motioned to approve the Agenda, seconded by Alderman Whitmore. The motion passed by a voice vote.

APPROVAL OF THE CONSENT AGENDA

Mayor Fortune asked if there were any changes to the Consent Agenda consisting of the June 2, 2021 Regular Session Minutes, June 2, 2021 Closed Session Minutes, the Bills List from May 29, 2021 to June 11, 2021 and Credit Card List from May 1, 2021 to May 31, 2021. Alderman Stoeckl motioned to approve the Consent Agenda seconded by Alderman Eisenhauer. The motion passed by voice vote.

REPORTS OF COMMITTEES/COMMISSIONS/CONTRACTORS

St. Louis County Police Department: Mayor Fortune introduced Captain Tanner and Sergeant Conrardy of the 7th Precinct. Both are new to the 7th Precinct this year. Each of the gentlemen had the opportunity to introduce themselves and give of brief background of their time with St. Louis County.

Mayor Fortune stated that the City is happy with Officer Wehner as our resident officer. He has been a great addition to the City.

Financial Statement-Jeff Blume: Jeff Blume, Financial Consultant, joined the meeting via Zoom. Mr. Blume reviewed the financial statement for May with the Board. The City's sales tax revenue is down approximately \$55,000.00 from this time last year. The City's overall revenues is down approximately \$58,000.00. Mr. Blume is concerned about this decrease since total retail sales at grocery stores are down. The trend at this time shows people are spending more money on services and going out to dinner. This is not good for the City at this time. He recommends a word of caution to the City to be aware of this trend in their capital spending and budget process. Other taxes are on target.

PRELIMINARY CITIZEN COMMENTS

Jeff Graves stated he liked the new wall which was installed at Boly Lane. The intersection he felt was more open and visible.

NEW BUSINESS

Bill No. 21-10-An Ordinance Creating The Position Of City Clerk/Administrator And Appointing Frank Johnson To The Position: First reading of Bill No. 21-10 was read. Mayor Fortune ask if there were any questions concerning Bill No. 21-10. The second reading of Bill No. 21-10 was read. Alderman Milne motioned to approve Bill No. 21-10, seconded by Alderman Whitmore and the motion passed on a roll call vote as follows: Aldermen Milne-yea, Eisenhauer-yea Whitmore-yea and Stoeckl-yea. Mayor Fortune stated that Bill No. 21-10 being duly passed becomes Ordinance No. 21-10.

Mayor Fortune issued the oath of office to City Clerk Johnson.

Bill No. 21-11-An Ordinance Approving Amendments To Municipal Code Chapter 610, Regulations Pertaining To Peddling, Soliciting And Canvassing: First reading of Bill No. 21-11 was read. Attorney Rost reviewed the changes that were made to Chapter 610 which were in accordance with the changes passed by the United States District Court. Mayor Fortune ask if there were any questions concerning Bill No. 21-11. The second reading of Bill No. 21-11 was read. Alderman Whitmore motioned to approve Bill No. 21-11, seconded by Alderman Eisenhauer and the motion passed on a roll call vote as follows: Aldermen Milne-yea, Eisenhauer-yea Whitmore-yea and Stoeckl-yea. Mayor Fortune stated that Bill No. 21-11 being duly passed becomes Ordinance No. 21-11.

Resolution 2021-20-A Resolution Of The Twin Oaks Board Of Aldermen Approving An Agreement With Nick Damato, DBA STL Holiday Lighting, For Annual Maintenance Of The Permanent Lighting Installed On Twin Oaks Town Hall: Mayor Fortune asked for any questions concerning Resolution 2021-20. Mayor Fortune asked for a motion to approve Resolution 2021-20. Alderman Milne motioned to approve Resolution 2021-20, seconded by Alderman Whitmore. The motion passed by voice vote of four yes, zero no. **Committee/Commission Reappointments:** City Clerk Johnson presented Mary Young for appointment to the Planning & Zoning Commission. Mayor Fortune asked for a motion to approve this Commission appointment. Alderman Eisenhauer motioned to approve the presented appointment, seconded by Alderman Milne. The motion passed by voice vote of four yes, zero no.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

Accounting RFP: The City had received two proposals for accounting services. In his review of the proposals City Clerk Johnson found that many of the firms also want to include the yearly Audit as well as the accounting work.

Ijaz Group is based out of Washington DC and it does not appear that they have a local office in St. Louis.

Kerber, Eck & Braeckel, LLP (KEB) have an office in St. Louis. City Clerk Johnson had a preliminary meeting with someone from the firm. He stated that this firm has worked with City's the size of Twin Oaks. Their fee is based on an hourly charge. Alderman Milne asked approximately how much time that Jeff Blume spends per month on the City's finances in hopes of making some kind of comparison.

City Clerk Johnson recommended scheduling a meeting with KEB to help with answering any questions the Board may have. The Board was in agreement to schedule a meeting. Mayor Fortune would like to have a representative from the KEB firm at the July 7th Work Session.

Alderman Stoeckl asked what the City is paying for Jeff Blume's services. At this time the City pays Mr. Blume \$1,500.00 a quarter. City Clerk Johnson stated that Mr. Blume would like to stay as the City's financial consultant. He proposed attend the Board meetings via Zoom and attend one meeting in person per quarter.

Birnamwood Condominium Drainage Channel Maintenance: City Clerk Johnson gave a brief history of this drainage area. MSD gave the City a stormwater easement agreement which allowed the City to go in and build the drainage area. This agreement, however does not promise that the City will maintain this area. The area is in need of repair but it is not an emergency at this time.

Alderman Milne asked if you can spend City money to repair something on private property. Attorney Rost stated that since it is a regional issue effecting stormwater you can spend City money to fix the problem.

The Condominium Association did get a bid from a tuck-pointing company for the repair. The Board would like to get two additional bids. City Clerk Johnson will work to attain these bids. Attorney Rost also stated that a permit from MSD may be required. The Contractor would be able to check on this and obtain if necessary.

ATTORNEY'S REPORT

If the Board agreed to go into Closed Session Attorney Rost would update the Board on a litigation issue.

CITY CLERK'S REPORT

General Updates

Bond Compliance Certification

• The City has completed its annual bond certification and reporting process as required for the 2017 Certificates of Participation issued to finance the construction of City Hall. See the annual report included in the board packet for more details.

Twin Oaks Branded Clothing

• A previous order placed for 12 embroidered items branded with the City logo was not able to be recalled following the June 2nd meeting. Therefore, no additional items for the Board of Aldermen are necessary. This order included T-shirts and hoodies for maintenance staff.

Project Updates

Twin Oaks Park Mulching

• Focal Pointe completed the mulching of the Twin Oaks Park on June 14. This completes the mulching work in the City for the year.

Tree Removal

• Davey removed the large tree in the Park on June 14.

Striping Maintenance

• Maintenance staff is currently working on restriping various locations throughout the City. The City Hall parking lot, Boly Lane and Autumn Leaf Drive have been completed.

Twin Oaks Presbyterian Church Berm

• BFA has suggested that we modify the berm plan to come in under the County's permit requirements. This could be accomplished by removing the swale from the plans and only constructing the berm. Staff discussed this with the Church management and is currently waiting to see if the Church's board would agree to this modification.

Alderman Whitmore asked if Public Works Director John Williams would be able to strip Meramec Station Road since the road is in need of restriping. City Clerk Johnson stated that Mr. Williams would not be able to do this striping, but the Board was in agreement to revisit the bids the City had received from Traffic Control last year on restriping Meramec Station Road.

Alderman Milne would like to have had a notice of the lane closure on Boly Lane sent out to the residents. Alderman Eisenhauer stated that in talking with Mr. Williams, he was notified the evening before by Crowder Construction that they were coming the next day.

MAYOR AND ALDERMAN COMMENTS

Alderman Whitmore likes the new retaining wall on Boly Lane, but feels that the wall is closer to the road than the previous wall and that reflectors may be needed on the wall. He also asked if the fireworks on October 16th will be beginning earlier. Mayor Fortune stated that yes they would be beginning around 8:15 pm.

Mayor Fortune stated that they are trying to think of a theme for the fireworks. He would like to have it reflect the heroes of the past year, i.e. essential workers, doctors, nurses, police, etc.

Alderman Stoeckl stated the City has quite a few new residents and wondered if the City sends anything to new residents. City Clerk Johnson stated that they receive a welcome letter and a New Resident booklet.

FINAL CITIZEN COMMENTS

There were no final citizen comments.

MOVE TO CLOSED SESSION

Alderman Whitmore motioned to go into closed session at 8:19 p.m. to discuss matters pursuant to Section 610.021 (1), seconded by Alderman Eisenhauer. The motion passed by roll call vote as follows: Aldermen Eisenhauer-yea, Milne-yea, Whitmore-yea and Stoeckl-yea.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 315 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF TWIN OAKS PERTAINING TO SPECIAL ENFORCEMENT AREAS AND DESIGNATING A PORTION OF CRESCENT ROAD AS SUCH.

WHEREAS, Section 315.120 of the Twin Oaks Municipal Code gives the Board of Aldermen authority to declare any street or part thereof a "special enforcement area" and to place signs or devices in the roadway indicating and helping to protect; and

WHEREAS, motor vehicle crashes are one of the leading causes of death in the United States, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen is greatly concerned for the safety of the City's residents, pedestrians, and motorists, and believes that controlling traffic maneuvers will decrease the likelihood of a fatal or disabling injury; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen has determined that a portion of Crescent Road should be designated as a special enforcement area for the purposes of public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF TWIN OAKS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Municipal Code Section 315.130 "Special Enforcement Areas" is hereby amended by adding a portion of Crescent Road to the list of special enforcement areas in Subsection B, as follows:

Section 315.130 Special Enforcement Areas.

A. Whenever authorized signs are erected pursuant to the authority granted in Section 315.120 indicating any street or part thereof as a special enforcement area, no person shall drive in such area without exercising the greatest care.

B. The following streets or portions thereof are hereby identified as special enforcement areas:

- 1. Autumn Leaf Drive, from its intersection with Boly Lane to its intersection with Birnamwood Trails Drive.
- 2. Boly Lane, entire length.
- 3. Crescent Avenue, from its intersection with Robert Hartzog Lane to its intersection with Crescent Road.
- 4. Crescent Road, from the western City limits two hundred (200) feet to the western edge of the driveway at 157 Crescent Road.

Section 2: The Municipal Code is further amended by adding a new Section 315.135 entitled "Special Enforcement Areas; Double Fines; Applicable Infractions," to read as follows:

Section 315.135 Special Enforcement Areas; Double Fines; Applicable Infractions.

- A. Establishment. The Board may determine that it is necessary for public safety in an area designated as a Special Enforcement Area, that fines be doubled. If such a determination is made by the Board, the standard fine for traffic violations set forth in subsection B in that area shall be doubled as set forth therein. Any streets, or portions thereof, within a Special Enforcement Area of the City that are designated by ordinance as double fine zones as provided herein shall be listed on a schedule entitled Schedule VIII Special Enforcement Area Double Fine Zones, appended to and printed in the City's Traffic Code.
- B. Double Fine Zone.
 - 1. If the Board designates a roadway, or portion thereof, as a Special Enforcement Area subject to double fines, anyone found guilty of a violation involving:
 - a. Sections 320.030 and 320.050 (speeding);
 - b. Section 340.220 (following too close);
 - c. Section 340.160 (careless and imprudent driving);
 - d. Section 340.180 (improper lane usage);
 - e. Section 330.020 (one-way streets and alleys); or
 - f. Sections 335.040 335.060 (failure to stop or yield);

in such a double fine zone shall be fined at a rate not less than double the standard fine for such violation as provided in the schedule established by the Municipal Court. Nothing herein shall authorize a fine over two hundred twenty-five dollars (\$225.00) inclusive of court costs for a Minor Traffic Violation (as defined in Section 100.220 of this Code).

C. Notice. Prior to the enforcement of any ordinance instituting a double fine zone, appropriate signage shall be installed notifying the traveling public of the existence of the Special Enforcement Area and that violators will be subject to double the standard fine. Notice shall also be made through the City's website for a period of up to thirty (30) days after the Board's designation of a Special Enforcement Area with a double fine zone.

<u>Section 3</u>: The Board further directs that *Schedule VIII – Double Fine Zones* be adopted and appended to and printed in the City's Traffic Code, as follows:

Schedule VIII – Special Enforcement Area - Double Fine Zones

Table I – Double Fine Zones

Location

Crescent Road, from the western City limits two hundred (200) feet to the western edge of the driveway at 157 Crescent Road

Section 4: Finally, the Board hereby further directs that at least thirty (30) days prior to the enforcement of the Double Fine Zones that:

- 1. Appropriate signage be installed notifying the public that traffic certain violations in the area are subject to double fines; and,
- 2. Notification be made through the City's website of this new Special Enforcement Area and penalty of double fines for traffic violations therein.



PERMANENT STORM WATER MANAGEMENT & SLOPE MAINTENANCE EASEMENT

This Indenture, made on the <u>12th</u> day of <u>July</u>, 1999, by and between Birnamwood Condominium, a Missouri condominium association, party of the first part, herein called landowner, and The Village of Twin Oaks, Missouri, an incorporated Missouri municipality, party of the second part;

WITNESSETH,

That the said landowner for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable considerations to it paid by the party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents, remise, release and forever quit claim unto the said party of the second part an easement over the following described lots, tract or parcels of land lying, being and situated in St. Louis County, State of Missouri, to-wit:

A variable width storm water management & slope maintenance and access easement, the location of which is shown hatched on the attached Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof by reference." The dimensions of said variable width easement are more particularly defined and described in attached Exhibits "A" and "B", which are incorporated herein by reference.

This easement is granted to the Village of Twin Oaks, Missouri for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, and removing storm water management pipes, manholes, channel lining, composite revetment, grade control structures and other storm water management equipment and facilities necessary and convenient to the operation of a storm water management system. Landowner agrees to make no claim of ownership of and to any storm water management system equipment or facilities installed in the easement described above.

The Village of Twin Oaks, Missouri is hereby granted a permanent right of reasonable and direct ingress and egress to the above described easement for the above purposes as delineated on Exhibit A. The Village will repair any damage which occurs to the landowners' drive due to accessing easement.

The Village is further granted, during the period of original construction of said storm water management system, the right of surface usage of reasonable areas adjacent to the described easement not to exceed 10 feet, to facilitate construction, but with the obligation to restore said areas upon completion. By recording this easement, the Village of Twin Oaks, Missouri further agrees that subsequent to original installation or future maintenance or removal of storm water management lines, equipment or facilities on said easement to restore the surface thereof as far as practicable to its prior condition.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, with all rights, privileges, appurtenances and immunities thereto belonging or in anyway appertaining, unto said party of the second part, its successors and assigns; the said party of the first part hereby covenanting that it is lawfully seized of an indefeasible estate in fee in the premises from which the permanent easement is herein conveyed and that it has good right to convey the same.





Section 225.030. Collection Of Solid Waste.

- A. The City shall provide for the collection of solid waste as follows:
 - 1. Collection Of Residential Solid Waste. The City shall provide for the collection of residential solid waste in the City; provided, however, that the City may provide the collection service by contracting with a person, County or other City or a combination thereof for the entire City or portions thereof as deemed to be in the best interests of the City.
 - 2. Other Collections. The City may, at its discretion, provide commercial solid waste collection services upon specific application of the owners or persons in charge thereof. However, in the event that such application is not made or approved, it shall be the duty of such establishment to provide for collection of all solid waste produced upon any such premises in a manner approved by City. If and when the City does provide commercial collection service, the provisions herein concerning such service shall apply.
- B. All solid waste from premises to which collection services are provided under contract with the City shall become the property of the collection agency upon being loaded into the transportation equipment.
- C. Solid waste containers as required by this Chapter for the storage of residential solid waste shall be placed at curbside for collection but shall not be so placed until after 6:00 P.M. on the day next preceding the regularly scheduled collection day. Containers shall be removed from curbside no later than 8:00 P.M. on the day of collection.
- D. Individuals desiring the collection of bulky rubbish shall deal directly with those licensed by the City for the collection of the same.
- E. Solid waste collectors, employed by the City or a solid waste collection agency operating under contract with the City, are hereby authorized to enter upon private property for the purpose of collecting solid waste therefrom as required by this Chapter. Solid waste collectors shall not enter dwelling units or other residential buildings for the purpose of collecting residential solid waste.
- F. It shall be the responsibility of the occupants of each dwelling unit to prepare, package and deliver solid waste to curbside for collection as prescribed in this Chapter and as it may be amended

from time to time or as the contract between the City and the solid waste hauler shall provide. [R.O. 2016 § 225.030(F); R.O. 2011 § 225.030; Ord. No. 99-1 § 3, 1-6-1999; Ord. No. 99-11 § 1, 2-3-1999; Ord. No. 2000-17 § 2, 9-6-2000; Ord. No. 372, 9-19-2012]

- G. It shall be the responsibility of each commercial, industrial, institutional or other non-residential generator of solid waste to prepare, package and store solid waste so generated as prescribed by this Chapter and as it may be amended from time to time.
- H. It shall be the responsibility of every solid waste collector to abide by this Chapter and receive and transport solid waste in a manner consistent with the provisions of this Chapter.
- I. The following collection frequencies shall apply to collections of solid waste within the City: All residential solid waste, other than bulky rubbish, shall be collected at least once weekly. All commercial solid waste shall be collected once weekly and shall be collected at such lesser intervals as may be fixed by the Board of Aldermen upon a determination that such lesser intervals are necessary for the preservation of the health and/or safety of the public.
- J. Residential solid waste containers shall be stored upon the residential premises. Except as provided in Subsection (C) hereof, all solid waste containers stored out-of-doors shall be stored behind any building located on the tract of land. Commercial solid waste containers shall remain in the location from which they are to be serviced except while being serviced.
- K. All solid waste collectors operating under contract with the City or otherwise collecting solid waste within the City limits shall be responsible for the collected solid waste from the point of collection to the point of disposal, provided the solid waste was stored in compliance with the applicable Sections of this Chapter. Any spillage or blowing litter caused as a result of the duties of the solid waste collector shall be collected and placed in the transportation vehicle by the solid waste collector.
- L. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation collecting and disposing of rubbish, garbage or waste material from premises in the residential districts or premises in any commercial district which abuts or adjoins a residential district in the City to make such collection or dispose of rubbish, garbage or

General Updates

Unleashed Dogs in the Park

• The City recently received a complaint about unleashed dogs in Twin Oaks Park. We will be sending out some additional information reminding residents about the ordinances regarding unleashed pets.

Trash and Recycling Delays

- On July 1, Mayor Russ Fortune met with Paul Bickford with Waste Management to discuss the recent issues the City has been experiencing with trash and recycling pickup.
- Further, the City has requested that Waste Management send two updates to the City each Monday and Friday on the status of pickup until more normal service is established.

Project Updates

Meramec Station Road Striping Mystery

- On June 24th, a portion of Meramec Station Road within the city limit was restriped. Both St. Louis County and Manchester have confirmed that, to their knowledge, the work was not completed by them. We have reached out to Valley Park but have not heard back.
- The City is moving forward with getting quotes for the remaining restriping work.

Asphalt Path Sealing

• Last week, Topps came out to the Park and sealed the asphalt paths. This required the park to be closed for two days. However, the heavy rain that followed then washed away much of the application, requiring Topps (at their expense) to come out to re-do the sealing on Monday and Tuesday.

Tree Removal

• Davey removed one large tree and several others in the Park on June 14th and removed the stumps last week.

Striping Maintenance

• Maintenance staff is currently working on restriping various locations throughout the City. Crescent Road will be completed this week.

Twin Oaks Presbyterian Church Berm

- On June 22nd, the City approved the revised berm proposal from Twin Oaks Presbyterian Church. The revised proposal eliminates the swale and will instead involve hauling in dirt and fill material to build up the berm. The City agreed to cover the additional cost incurred by these revisions, up to \$1,700.
- As the revised proposal involves less than 2,000 square feet, no permit from St. Louis County is necessary and the project can move forward.

Drainage Channel in Birnamwood Condos

• Maintenance Supervisor John Williams is working to get quotes for this potential project from Crowder and DJM.
